



# DOG WALKING AGREEMENT

The Service Provider and the Client are collectively referred to as the “Parties.”

## 1. Scope of Services

1.1. The Service Provider agrees to provide dog walking services (“Services”) for the Client’s dog(s) in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

1.2. The Services include walking the dog(s), ensuring reasonable care and safety during walks, and informing the Client of any notable incidents or concerns.

1.3. The Services do not include training, grooming, veterinary services, or medical diagnosis unless expressly agreed in writing.

## 3. Service Location and Schedule

3.3. Any changes to the schedule must be communicated in advance and are subject to the Service Provider’s availability.

## 4. Responsibilities of the Service Provider

The Service Provider shall:

- a) perform the Services with reasonable care, skill, and diligence;
- b) comply with applicable local laws, regulations, and leash requirements;
- c) use appropriate walking equipment;
- d) take reasonable precautions to prevent injury, escape, or harm;
- e) clean up after the dog(s) during walks;
- f) notify the Client promptly of any incident, injury, or unusual behavior.

## 5. Responsibilities of the Client

The Client shall:

- a) provide accurate and complete information regarding the dog(s);
- b) ensure the dog(s) are fit for walking and legally owned or controlled by the Client;
- c) provide necessary equipment (leash, collar, identification tags, etc.);
- d) ensure timely access to the dog(s) at the scheduled time;
- e) promptly notify the Service Provider of any changes to health, behavior, or contact information.

## 6. Health Condition and Illness Disclosure

- 6.1. The Client confirms that the dog(s) are, to the best of the Client's knowledge, in good health, except as disclosed in writing.
- 6.2. The Client shall disclose any illnesses, injuries, contagious diseases, chronic conditions, allergies, disabilities, or behavioral issues that may affect the dog's safety or ability to be walked.
- 6.3. The Client agrees to immediately notify the Service Provider of any change in the dog's health condition.
- 6.4. The Service Provider reserves the right to refuse or suspend Services if the dog's condition poses a risk to the dog, other animals, the Service Provider, or the public.

## 7. Medical Care and Medication

- 7.1. The Client represents and warrants that all medical and health information provided is true, accurate, and complete.
- 7.2. The Client shall disclose all medications, supplements, or treatments the dog is receiving on a regular or ongoing basis. Medications:

- 7.3. Where medication administration is required, the Client shall provide:
  - a) sufficient medication in clearly labeled packaging;
  - b) clear written instructions;
  - c) information on possible side effects.
- 7.4. The Service Provider shall not administer medication unless expressly agreed in writing and proper instructions are provided.
- 7.5. The Client acknowledges that the Service Provider is not a licensed veterinarian and is not responsible for medical diagnosis or treatment decisions.

## 8. Emergency Veterinary Care

## **9. Fees, Payment and Cancellation**

- 9.3. All applicable taxes, including GST, shall be borne by the Client unless otherwise agreed.

## **10. Term and Termination**

- 10.1. This Agreement shall commence on \_\_\_\_\_ and continue until terminated.
- 10.2. Either Party may terminate this Agreement by providing \_\_\_\_\_ days written notice.
- 10.3. The Service Provider may terminate immediately in case of non-payment or material breach by the Client.

## **11. Absence or Unavailability of the Service Provider**

- 11.1. If the Service Provider is unable to perform the Services due to illness, emergency, or other unavoidable circumstances, the Client shall be notified as soon as reasonably practicable.
- 11.2. The Service Provider may, with the Client's consent, arrange a temporary substitute, but is not obligated to do so.
- 11.3. No fees shall be payable for Services not rendered due to the Service Provider's absence, unless otherwise agreed.
- 11.4. Temporary absence shall not constitute a breach of this Agreement.

## **12. Liability of the Service Provider**

- 12.1. The Service Provider shall not be liable for injury, illness, loss, or death of the dog arising from:
- a) pre-existing or undisclosed conditions;
  - b) natural behavior of the dog;
  - c) actions of third parties, animals, or environmental factors beyond reasonable control.
- 12.2. The Service Provider shall only be liable for direct damages caused by gross negligence or willful misconduct.
- 12.3. The Service Provider shall not be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages.

12.4. Total liability, if any, shall not exceed the fees paid by the Client during the preceding three (3) months, unless required by law.

### **13. Liability of the Client and Indemnification**

13.1. The Client remains fully responsible for the dog's behavior and actions.

13.2. The Client warrants that the dog is vaccinated and does not pose a known danger, except as disclosed.

13.3. The Client agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Service Provider from any claims, losses, damages, or expenses arising from:

- a) the dog's behavior;
- b) inaccurate or incomplete information provided by the Client;
- c) violation of applicable laws;
- d) breach of this Agreement by the Client.

13.4. Veterinary expenses, fines, or damages related to the dog remain the Client's responsibility, except where caused by the Service Provider's gross negligence.

### **14. Governing Law and Jurisdiction**

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India, and courts of competent jurisdiction shall have exclusive authority.

### **15. Entire Agreement**

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes all prior discussions or understandings. Any amendments must be made in writing and signed by both Parties.
